GIRL: Wasn't it fun at the temple today? I love it when we get to go there, there's so many people and different things going on. I especially like going when parents bring their first-born baby boys to the temple to give the offerings to buy their baby back from God.

SISTER: Why do they have to buy the oldest baby boy back again from God?

GIRL: Remember the stories of Moses and his fight against Pharaoh, how Moses finally won when God sent his angel to kill all the oldest sons in Egypt?

SISTER: Yes! That's the Passover story, I love the Passover and the supper and having the whole family over. I remember the story, but not why we sacrifice for the babies still.

GIRL: To keep their children safe, God told them to kill a lamb and put its blood on the door posts and the angel would fly over that house.

SISTER: Is that why some of our neighbors do that just before Passover?

GIRL: That's right. And because the lamb saved the babies then, God reminds us that the oldest sons are still his and we have to offer a sacrifice for them to give thanks and to remember how he saved us.

SISTER: But some of the parents only gave 2 small birds. Those parents by the old man Simeon only offered 2 pigeons.

GIRL: That's right. Richer people still give a lamb, but poorer people could give 2 birds instead. Those parents must be poor.

SISTER: I see. Do those sacrifices mean anything else?

GIRL: The sacrifices also mean that the oldest boy is supposed to serve God for the rest of his life. For the Levites that is so for them, but that boy from that poor family, he is supposed to serve God his whole life.
